



Dear Ernie:

We are writing as a follow-up to conditions 2.1 and 3.1 of WW-4-3486 for Lot 1 with an existing 3 bedroom single family residence served by a new on-lot individual drilled well and Lot 2, a new four bedroom single family residence served by a new on-lot drilled well and a new septic tank and pump station that convey effluent to the new shared mound system located on Lot 1. The original parcel and now Lot 1 is at 130 Old Stage Road in Essex, VT.

The system was constructed by Don Weston Excavating, Inc. and inspected by myself on May 28, 2010 (mound area preparation, mound sand approval), September 15, 2010 (force main test) and October 22, 2010 (Hard wired pump station and drilled wells).

In accordance with condition 2.1 "I hereby certify that in the exercise of my reasonable professional judgment, the installation-related information submitted is true and correct and the potable water supply was installed in accordance with: the permitted design and all permit conditions; or record drawings and such record drawings are in compliance with the applicable rules, were filed with the Secretary, and are in accordance with all other permit conditions; was inspected, was properly tested, and has successfully met those performance tests".

In accordance with condition 3.1 "I hereby certify that in the exercise of my reasonable professional judgment, the installation-related information submitted is true and correct and the wastewater system was installed in accordance with: the permitted design and all permit conditions; or record drawings and such record drawings are in compliance with the applicable rules, were filed with the Secretary, and are in accordance with all other permit

conditions; was inspected, was properly tested, and has successfully met those performance tests".

In accordance with the approved plans and permit, Lot #1 will continue to utilize its existing on-lot sewage area until failed as discussed in condition 3.3 and per condition 3.3, when failed the new pump station and delivery system to the shared mound system is required to be inspected and a certification provided in accordance with condition 3.1.
