Attached are the results for both the July 2023 study and the most recent November 2023 study. The average vehicles per day per vehicle category were consistent between the two studies with the exception of the single unit trucks, (medium size). There was noticeable increase from an average of 155 vehicles per day to 878. This could be attributed to several things. This time of year, there is a substantial increase in the number of delivery vehicles would account for this increase. Another issue would be the period the data was collected. The data collected for the summer traffic counts began on a Thursday and ended the following Thursday morning. This count included weekend traffic where the traffic counts collected in November was Monday to Friday. This could have skewed some of the recent counts.

Public Works recommends moving forward with the UPWP grant application through the CCRPC so the Town can work with a consultant to complete a full traffic study within the corridor, so we all can make sense of the traffic data collected.
