



Homestead Declaration

By Vermont law, property owners whose homes meet the definition of a Vermont homestead must file a Homestead Declaration annually by the April filing deadline. If you own a home in Vermont, you will want to see if you can claim your home. essexvt.gov/homestead



Property Tax Bills are mailed to property owners in August. The first installment is due in September and the second installment is due in

March. Payments must be postmarked by the due date to avoid penalty. Sign up for the automatic tax program! essexvt.gov/taxes
